JIM AHERN OF LANSING CATHOLIC CENTRAL SELECTED AS DETROIT LIONS HIGH SCHOOL COACH OF THE YEAR

Jim Ahern of Lansing Catholic High School has been selected as the 2019 Detroit Lions HS Coach of the Year. He led his Cougars to a 13-1 record and the Division 5 State Championship, with a 31-17 victory over Almont in the state final game at Ford Field. This marked LCC's second state championship, having won the title in 1985.

Coach Ahern has had a long and illustrious career as a coach in Michigan. At LCC, he has gotten his team to the state finals three times (2011, 2014, 2019) and the semifinals again in 2015, since taking over the program in 2009.

His career began as an assistant at Kalamazoo Hackett and North Branch. This led him to his first head coaching position at Gobles HS, where he also served as athletic director. After three years at Gobles, he spent 31 years at Ithaca HS as head coach and Director of Guidance and Counseling. At Ithaca, he won 197 games, won 8 league championships, made 13 playoff appearances and was

named MHSFCA Regional Coach of the Year seven times.

Coach Ahern retired from Ithaca in 2003 and went to Florida, where he coached at Palmetto Ridge HS and East Lee County HS. He returned to Michigan to take over the Lansing Catholic program for the 2009 season.

In addition, Coach Ahern has been a long-time, major contributor to the MHSFCA. He has been a member since 1972 and served on the Board of Directors from 1978-1988. As a director, he was on the clinic committee from 1978-1988 and the playoff committee from 1980-1988, helping revamp the playoff system during that time. He served the association as vice president in 1988 and 1989 and president on 1990. He has been an integral part of the past presidents' council since 1991.

Congratulations to Coach Jim Ahern on this tremendous honor!

Mike Braid, Oakridge

Mike has helped work with the Oakridge High School Football team for over 25 years. He was taken in by our former head football coach Jack Schugars when he first arrived in Muskegon. Since then, Mike has become a fixture in the sports medicine/ athletic training community in Muskegon and throughout the state of Michigan. Mike works hard for "his" athletes. He calls them his because he feels an ownership in them due to the hours and hours he spends with them. Whether it be preparing for an upcoming season in Mike's functional training workouts, or rehabbing them after an injury, Mike works hard to get them ready to succeed. Over the years, there have been many schools that have tried to lure Mike away from being our Head Athletic Trainer, but none have been successful because of the loyalty we have shown to Mike and the relationships that have been

built over the last 25 years with various head coaches, assistant coaches, administrators and athletes. In turn, Mike's loyalty to Oakridge, our coaches and athletes has been unwavering. When he stands in front of a group of athletes and addresses them, he uses the term "we" He uses that term because he feels that. He feels part of the Oakridge Family. Mike considers himself an Oakridge Eagle just as any coach, athlete, employee or alumnus would.
