1993 Hall of Fame to Induct 28

Featured Speaker - Jim Harkema



In 1987, shortly after taking the then *Hurons* to a MAC Championship and a victorious trip to the California Bowl, EMU's Jim Harkema addressed the MHSFCA Winners Circle Clinic.

Schembechler among others... Eastern Michigan's Jim Harkema will be the featured speaker at the '93 ceremony.

Coach Harkema was hired to resurrect the Eastern Michigan football program in 1983 and developed Eastern into a top Mid-American Conference team. Harkema directed the 1987 *Hurons* to the school's first ever MAC Championship. That team also captured the California Bowl title on the way to a 10-2 overall record. Jim was named Mac "Coach of the Year" for his efforts that season. Harkema followed that success with second place finishes in 1988 (6-3-1) and 1989 (7-3-1), just missing return trips to the California Bowl.

At the summer meeting of the MHSFCA Board of Directors the possibility of affiliating with a recruiting service was discussed. The Regional Directors overwhelmingly rejected the idea. At the fall meeting this resolve was reiterated.

The reason for the decision to avoid any entanglements with recruiting services was simply stated by Tim Klein (Frankfort), "Why do we need a recruiting service to do something we should — and do — do ourselves?" It was also suggested at the fall meeting that we provide some tips both in the *Newsletter* and at the clinic to help coaches deal with recruiting (See, *Improving the Student Athlete Recruiting Process, Newsletter*, March 1992).

After 19 years as a collegiate head coach with an overall coaching record of 109-86-6 and a ten year record of 41-57-5 at Eastern, Jim resigned his coaching position four games into the 1992 season. He said of that decision, "I will continue to serve EMU (as associate athletic director in charge of game operations)... to help take this program to the next level. I'm basically proud of our accomplishments but I am disappointed we didn't take the program further. I felt we needed new leadership at this time and that's why I stepped down."

The Academic All State Committee takes great pride in announcing the sixth
MHSFCA Academic All State Football Team.

Of the 24 students selected to the 1992 team, 15 are ranked first in their class, four were ranked number two. Eleven of the 24 earned at least a 4.0 grade point average, while the other 13 earned at least a 3.88 during their first six semesters of high school. The 24 First Team members also mastered the ACT: 12 earned scores between 30 and 33 (one scored 33, five scored 32, seven scored 30), ten scored 29 and one scored 28.

I Formation Off-Tackle Offense

Running the I formation at Divine Child High School over the last fourteen years has been our trademark. We run the ball to the tight end side of the formation because we feel that is the strength of our team. We attack our opponent's defensive end in three

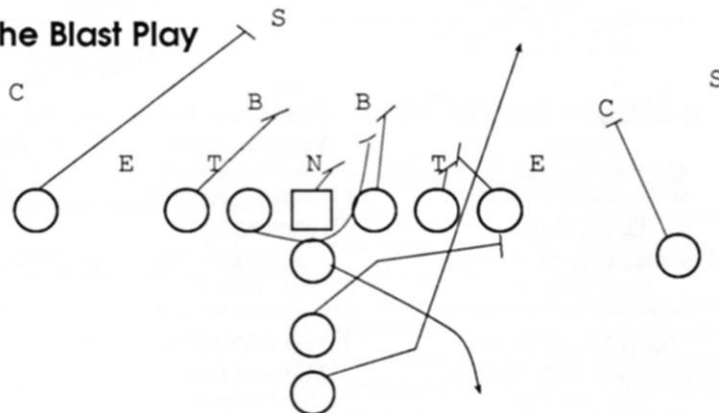
ways: 1. We blast the defensive end with our fullback. 2. We trap him with our near guard. 3. Finally, we base block the end with our tight end. All three attacks are out of the same backfield action.

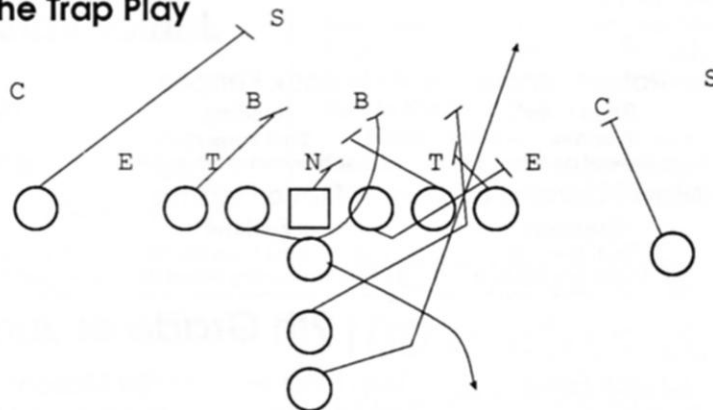
The Blast Play is nothing new. It is a simple off-tackle isolation play that all of us have run. The quarterback opens to the playside at a 45 angle, sprints to the outside leg of the tackle, and hands the ball off to the tailback. The tailback takes a lead step, then a crossover step, and finally drives toward the outside hip of the tackle. The fullback takes a jab step and drives to the inside hip of the defensive end. The fullback's job is to turn the end out. The tailback's aim is to make his cut off the fullback's block.

The Blast Play



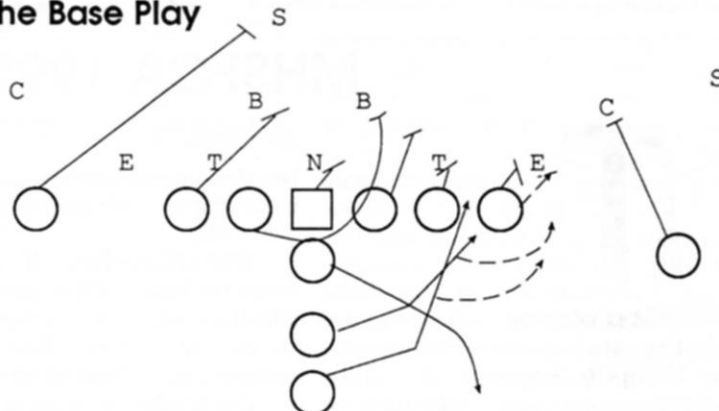
The trap play is run when the defensive end starts to attack our fullback in the backfield. When this happens, we pull the near guard and kick the end out. The fullback leads up the hole and blocks the linebacker.

The Trap Play



The base play is run when our guard cannot block the front side linebacker. When this happens, the tight end blocks the defensive end. Both fullback and tailback read the tight end's block. The fullback picks up the front side linebacker. The tailback cut's off the end's block.
