

Architect's Drawing of MHSFCA Hall of Fame Unveiled

at Winter Board of Directors Meeting



ed Dingens of Herrington & Dingens, Architects presented initial sketches and plans for the proposed building to house the MHS-FCA Hall of Fame at the Clare Meeting of the Board of Directors on November 30th. Mr. Dingens' presentation included a discussion of possible sites for the building in the area of the University of Michigan Football Stadium. He also updated Directors onenegotiations with the University indicating that discussions for the project were moving along rapidly and that he was encouraged by the receptiveness and cooperation of University representatives.

Several Directors expressed enthusiasm for the designs, the site possibilities, the hammered copper football... and the fact that progress on the project has finally taken a firm step forward. Past President Bob Knight, Portage Central, complemented Mr. Dingens on the "8000% improvement over anything we've seen so far."

Specific requirements

- To receive a 15 year certificate, must have been a coach in a particular sport for 15 school years
- To receive a 25 year certificate, must have been a coach in a particular sport for 25 school years
