Twenty-nine student-athletes automatically qualified for the First Team this year by scoring 295 or above on our 300 point scale. Of those 29 players who qualified, 17 were ranked 1st in their class. Of the 163 total applicants, 38 were ranked 1st in their class. The 29 First Team members also scored highly on the ACT/SAT: one scored 35, three scored 34, three scored 33, seven scored 32, nine scored 31, and five scored 30. Twenty-five of the 29 First Team members have a 4.0 gpa or better.

- To receive a 15/20/25/30/35/40 year certificate/ plaque in for coaching sports in general you must have been coaching at least one sport per year for that number of years at any level
