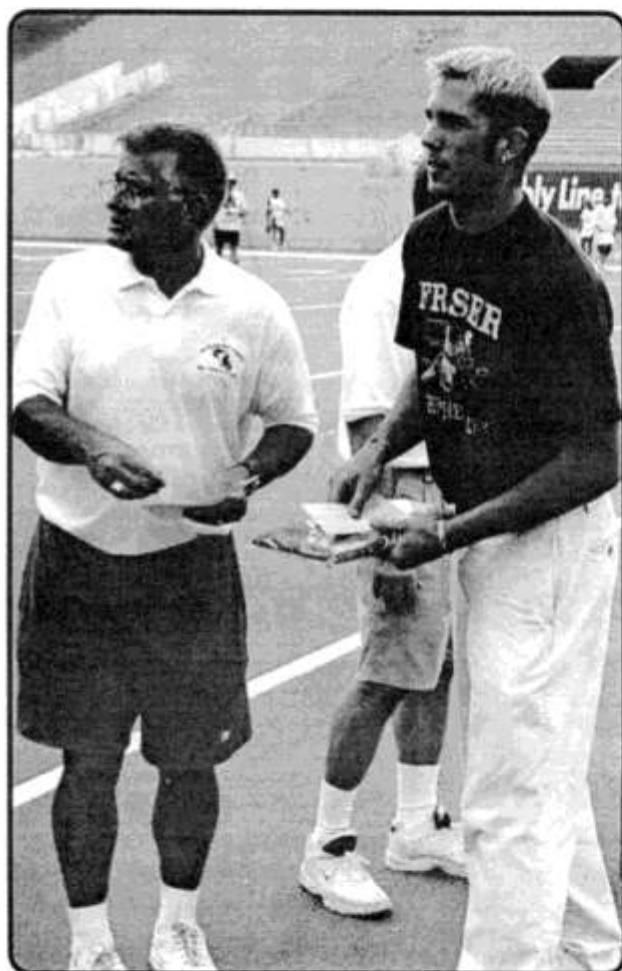

MHSFCA REGIONAL DIRECTORS What Do They Do?

MHSFCA Regional Directors are expected to make a serious commitment to serve the Association. Directors are expected to attend each of the four scheduled yearly meetings of the association: the Fall meeting held in Clare on the 1st Friday after the football championship games; The Winter meeting on the morning of the 1st day of the Winners' Circle Clinic; The Spring meeting on the Friday before the Hall of Fame Banquet; The Summer meeting on the Thursday and Friday prior to the All Star Game.

In addition to the regularly scheduled meetings of the full Board, Regional Directors are obligated to attend the All Star selection meeting in East Lansing in early January, they are expected to attend and help with the administration of the Hall of Fame Banquet, the Leadership Conference and the All Star Game.

Each Regional Director will also be assigned to one or more of the standing committees of the association. Participation in that/those committees may involve additional meetings and will always require the Director's talents.

Article X

The Board of Directors

Section 1

The management of the affairs of the association shall be vested in a Board of Directors which shall consist of two (2) directors from each of sixteen (16) regions, the president, two vice-presidents, and Executive Director, an historian, a chaplain, committee chairmen, and past presidents.

Section 2

The sixteen regions shall correspond with regions one (1) through fifteen (15) of the regional organization plan of the Michigan Education Association. Region sixteen (16) will correspond with MEA regions 16 through 18.

Section 3

Election of directors shall be held at the annual state meeting held at the Coaches Clinic each year.

Section 4

- A. The term of office of a regional director shall be two years: Regions 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, 11, 13, and 15 electing on odd years and regions 2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12, 14, and 16 electing on even years.
- B. Failure of a region to elect directors at the proper time shall leave that region without such representation until the president recommends for Board approval, a person to fill the vacancy.
- C. Should a member of the Board leave the coaching profession or move to a school in another region, the president shall appoint, upon recommendation of the other director, a temporary director from the region for the remainder of the term.
- D. It is recommended to the president that he instruct the members to seek in their selection of directors, those qualities necessary for

future officers as well as men vitally interested in promoting the interest of the association.

- E. To be a director, interested coaches must send letters to the (First Vice President) asking that their names be placed on their regional ballots. The two coaches receiving the highest number of votes will become regional directors.

Section 5

The Board of Directors shall have complete control and management of the affairs, funds, and property of the association.

The Finance Committee of the Board of Directors shall audit, or have audited by an independent firm, the financial records of the association once each year and make a report to the Board.

Section 6

- A. The Board of Directors shall meet at the following times:
 1. The spring meeting will be held on the Friday of the week-end of the Hall of Fame Banquet.
 2. The summer meeting will be held to coincide with the All Star Game.
 3. The fall meeting will be held on the first Friday after the football playoff Final Games in a centrally located city of the state.
 4. The winter meeting will be held on the afternoon preceding (or the morning of) the annual clinic.
- B. Expenses and/or mileage will be paid when possible.

Section 7

The Board of Directors shall meet by a call of the president or by a call of the majority of the Board of Directors.

Local Football Programs and Communities Make All Star Game Possible!

Many of us were around in the early days of the All Star Game - finding sponsorships for the game has never been easy. One of the things we have always been able to count on has been the support of our membership. Many of you regularly purchase game tickets, even if you can't make it to East Lansing for the game. Many of you have had players in the game and have helped them organize to canvas your communities for support. Those communities have always come through!

The 1999 game once again was a financial question mark after several corporate sponsors declined to participate in the 1998 game. In order to close the gap between the cost of the game and the bleak corporate sponsorship outlook the All Star Committee raised the goal from the \$500 per player (which had held from 1986-1998) to \$1000. Spartan Stadium was in the midst of its first year of a four year rejuvenation project which had the entire west side of the stadium, including the press box, closed to spectators and the weather was predicted to be perhaps the hottest and stormiest ever for an All Star Game. Despite these adversities the 1999 All Star Game Closed out the second decade of play and the Millennium with yet another great day of festivities. The band, cheerleaders and teams on the field provided an exciting afternoon of Michigan High School football... and the stormy weather passed to the north and south.

When it was all over the West had put together the largest margin of victory in the 19 year series by defeating the East 35 - 9.

Observations: No team has won more than two games in a row. 12 of the 19 games have been decided by a touchdown or less. The West has never been shut out, the East has been shut out three times: 1985, 1992, 1994. 13 of the 19 games (68%) have been decided by 10 points or less.

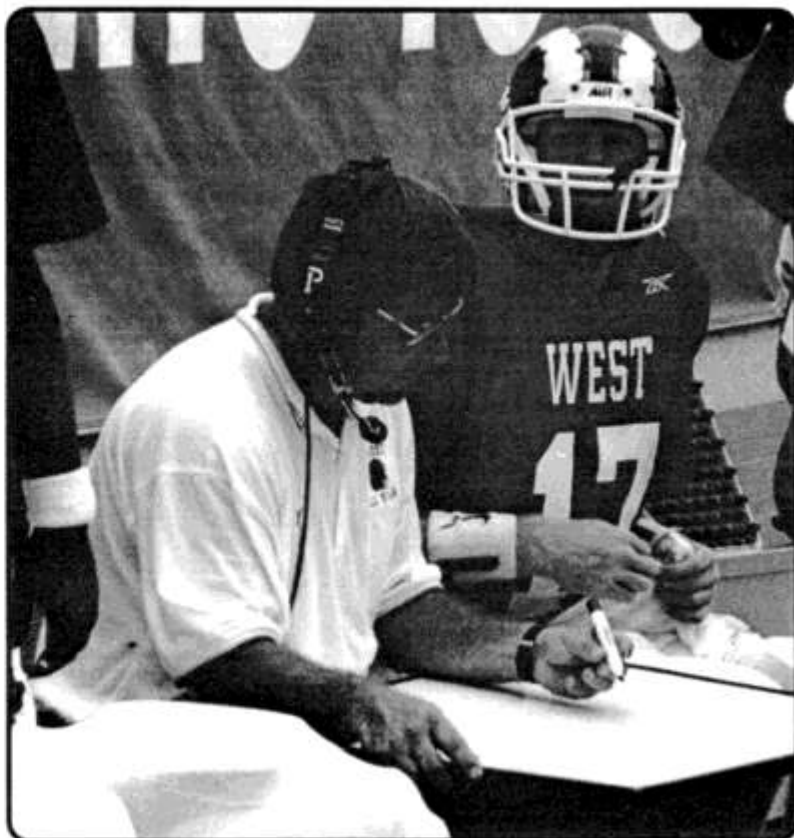
