MHSFCA Scholarship

The Michigan High School Football Coaches Scholarship is intended to reward personal excellence in school and community. Students involved in a football program may apply for this scholarship. The scholarship has a value of \$1000. To be considered for this scholarship your head football coach must be a member of the Michigan High School Football Coaches Association. Applicants receive consideration for the scholarship on the basis of: 1. Academic excellence, 2. ACT/SAT 3. Demonstrated service to school, community and church, 4. Evidenced leadership ability, 5. Citizenship.

Who is Eligible to Apply?

In order to be considered for a scholarship, a candidate must:

- Be a student involved in the football program as a player, cheerleader, manager, trainer or statistician.
- Be a student in the graduating class of a high school, who is a citizen of the United States of America and resident of the State of Michigan.
- Have outstanding personal character and behavior as a leader in their high school community.
- Be a student of outstanding merit, who shows an appreciation of the value of education and is willing to work to achieve success.
- Rank in the upper one quarter of their class and have test scores ACT or SAT that indicate academic success.
- Have on record a letter of acceptance from an accredited college or university.

What are the Policies of the MHSFCA Scholarship Program?

- Must be enrolled as a full time student in an accredited college or university.
- Scholarships are for one year only and are not renewable.
- The following merit standards will be used:
 - Scholarship and Testing 350 points
 - Leadership & Character 400 points

How Does A Candidate Apply?

- Obtain a Standard MHSFCA Scholarship Application Form, available from the MHSFCA Scholarship Chair. In addition to the application form, the following are essential in the order indicated:
 - Statement of not more than 300 words prepared by the candidate summarizing school and out-of-school activities, accomplishments and a statement of the applicant's objective for further education.
 - A transcript of the student's high school educational record from ninth grade through the first semester of their senior year, including class rank, total number of students in their senior class, grade point average, and ACT/SAT scores.
 - A comprehensive letter of recommendation covering leadership, character and scholarship from at least three people.

When Must Application be Submitted?

All Applications must be submitted to the MHSFCA Scholarship Committee before March 1 of their senior year.

Candidates will be advised of the decision of the Scholarship Committee before May 1.
