Hall of Fame History

The Hall of Fame opened officially on April 16, 1982. The Hall of Fame became a reality because of the planning and effort of a committee headed by Ron Holland, Tom Fagan, Chuck Ritter and many of the past presidents.

The Hall of Fame was originally located in the lobby of the University of Michigan's (old/original) indoor football practice facility. At that time, Coach of the Year Recipients, Hall of Fame Inductees, East/West All Star Game Footballs and Pictures, Scholarship Recipients, Jim Crowley Award Recipients, "Gold Brick" Contributing Schools and many other significant and historical items associated with High School Football in the State of Michigan were displayed. At the present time, those items and additional items of historical significance are available for review on our Virtual Hall of Fame accessed through the Association's' website, MHSFCA.com.

The first inductees to the Hall of Fame, The Class of 1982, were the original Board of Directors. They were inducted at the 1982 MHSFCA clinic. The Inaugural Class of 1982 included: Roy Allen, Dick Comar, Dave Driscoll, Art Gillespie, Ron Holland, Wayne Melchiori, Ike Muhlenkamp, Jim Ooley, Fred Rademacher, Dutch Schroetenboer, Tom Seroczynski, Jeff Smith, Steve Sonaga, and Jack VerDuin. In 1992, the Inaugural Class was formally re-inducted with a banquet and induction ceremony.

The Class of 2021 was not inducted in 2021 because of COVID. The Class of 2021 was formally inducted in 2022 along with the Class of 2022.

Tonight's inductees join an elite group of men who have contributed years of their lives to making Michigan high school football what it is today. As of tonight, the total number of inductees to the MHSFCA Hall of Fame stands at 853.

"Bo" Schembechler, suggested to then Hall of Fame Chair, Tom Fagan, that we needed to do a "first class" induction ceremony and offered to host the event and secure noteworthy guest speakers. Since then, the induction ceremonies have been held in Ann Arbor, East Lansing, and Detroit. Guest speakers have included "Woody" Hayes, Ara Parseghian, "Duffy" Daugherty, Dave Driscoll, Don Canham, Alex Agase, George Perles, Herb Deromedi, many Michigan and Head Coaches: "Bo" Schembechler, Gary Moeller, Lloyd Carr, Rich Rodriguez, Brady Hoke and Jim Harbaugh.

The Hall of Fame Committee: Chair Jon Herstein, Historian Jack Carlson, Executive Director Andrew Pratley, Communications Director Nick Maksimchuk, Director Larry Merx, and Director Tom Iwanicki have worked since last year's induction ceremony to make sure tonight is the first class event that our inductees have earned.

The Michigan High School Football Coaches Association is extremely proud of the Hall of Fame. It was, and is, one of the primary purposes for establishing the MHSFCA.

Selection Process

In 1986, Jack Carlson, former football coach at West Ottawa High School in Holland, Michigan, was appointed Historian of the MHSFCA. Jack replaced Harley Pierce of Sturgis High School, Past President and Historian of the Association.

Adopting the format used by Mr. Pierce, Jack computerized all of the information compiled from all the "paper" nomination forms submitted for consideration to the Hall of Fame. Presently, Jack has well over 200 nominations for the Hall of Fame with 125 currently eligible for induction having the required 100 victories as a head coach and/or a minimum 20 years coaching.

With such a large number of deserving candidates, it was necessary to establish specific criteria for those most worthy

of receiving this honor of induction to the Hall of Fame. The initial criteria for nomination, established by the Hall of Fame Committee, comprised of the Past Presidents of the Association, was: 100 victories as a varsity head coach and/or a minimum of 20 years coaching high school related football in the State of Michigan. This was and still remains the basic criteria of the award.

Additionally, the Hall of Fame Committee has established the following guidelines for consideration when selecting future inductees to the Hall of Fame. They are: date the nomination was received, age, and health of the nominee.

Wall of Fame & Virtual Hall of Fame

The Michigan High School Football Coaches Association opened its "Wall of Fame" at the University of Michigan Stadium in October 2010. The Wall of Fame displays each class of Hall of Fame Coaches and on individual plaques, the current inductees. Tonight's inductees' plaques will be hung later this spring to replace those inducted last year. After one year of having this year's inductees' plaques displayed for the entire Michigan Wolverine's football season, our current inductees' plaques will be taken down, mounted and delivered to tonight's new Hall of Fame members. The wall also features the names

of the "Gold Brick" schools, whose contributions helped to make the Wall of Fame a reality. Find the Wall of Fame on the inside of the South East Tower (nearest Chrysler Arena) at the stadium.

The online, "Virtual Hall of Fame," is up and running and can be accessed at MHSFCA.com. A work in progress, the Virtual Hall of Fame will include information on all aspects of the MHSFCA, from the very earliest documents regarding the establishment of the association, to the most recent. Eventually, any part of the MHSFCA which has been documented will be accessible for all Michigan High School Football Fans. Wall of Fame Expansion Project - Completed Spring 2023
